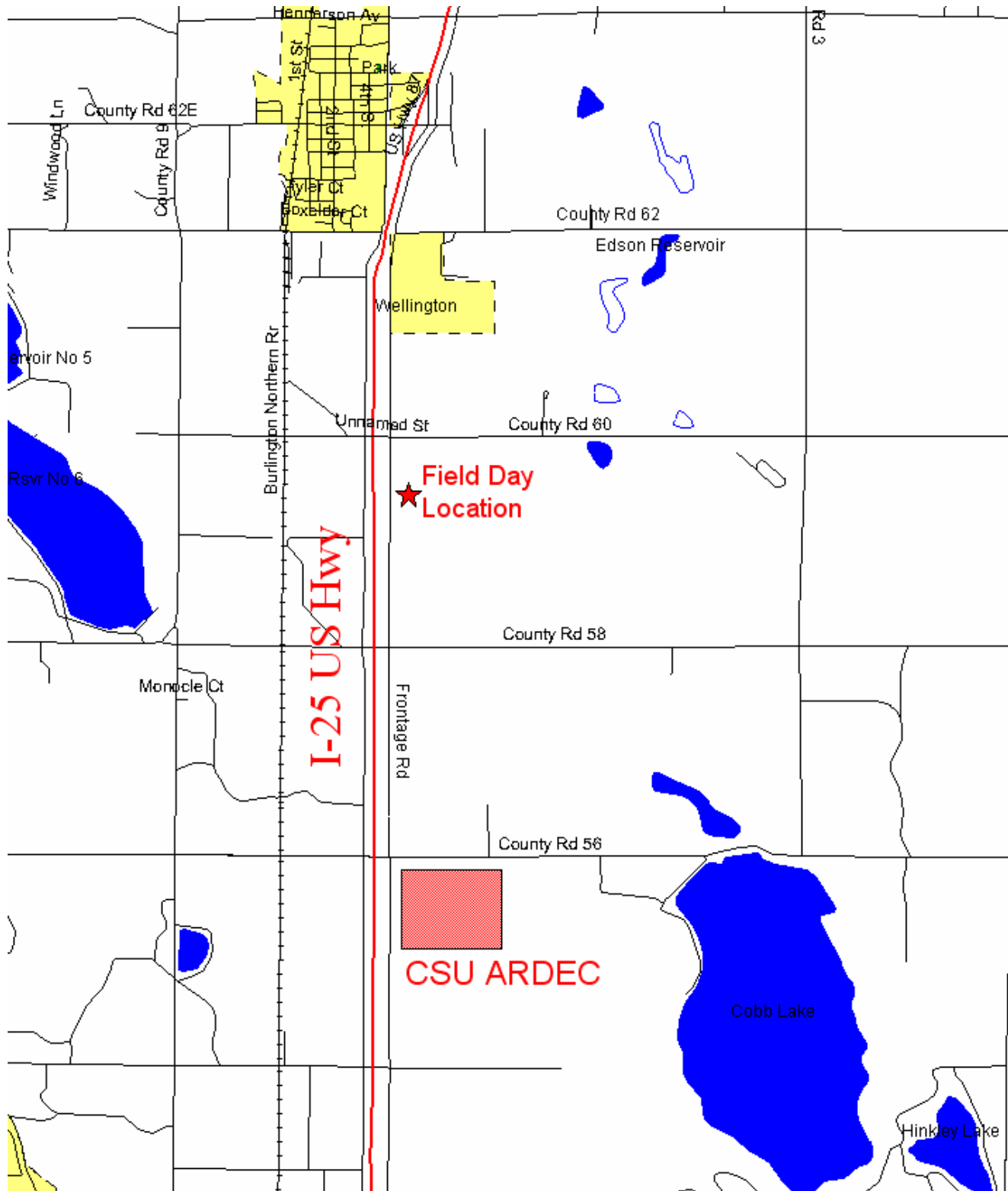

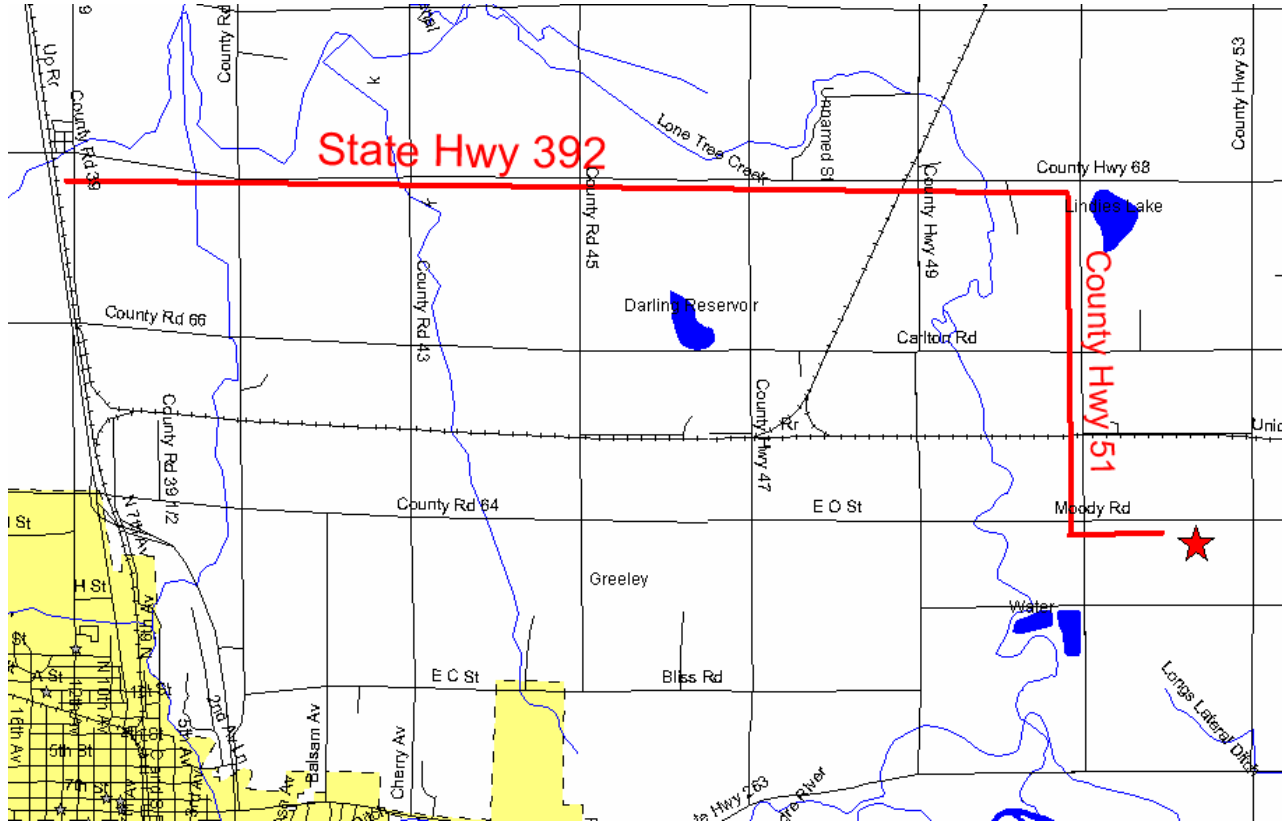


Fort Collins ARDEC Location for Field Day August 1st, 2007 at 9:30am to 12 noon
